

IMPORTANT INFO RE: DRY GRAD 2013

What is Dry Grad?

Dry Grad is an event which provides students with a safe, drug and alcohol-free environment to celebrate their graduation. It is a fully supervised fun event, sponsored by the Parents, where the grads can party with their friends, be entertained and participate in a fun-filled, action-packed night of celebration.

When is it?

Dry Grad takes place after the dinner dance on **Friday June 14th, 2013**. It will occur at the Ladner Community Centre and run from midnight until 6:00 am June 15th. Grads leave the dinner dance around midnight and return to Ladner for a quick clothing change before heading to the Dry Grad Event. The grads must be in the door by a set time and they do not have in/out privileges.

Who is organizing this event?

PARENTS of the graduating class are the primary organizers however they welcome volunteers from the Grade 11 class as well. There are a number of committees who need volunteers and there is definitely a job that suits every parent. Please contact the committee Chair for details: Vicki Fenn -

What does it cost to host the event?

The expense of holding the Dry Grad event is approximately \$165.00 per grad. The cost to the student for their admission into Dry Grad is between \$10-\$15, which gives them a commemorative T-shirt, a collection DVD of their Grad experience, food, entertainment and \$\$\$ prizes if they stay until 6:00am.

What is the difference between Dry Grad and Grad Council?

The grad council raises funds to offset the price of their ticket to the dinner dance at a Vancouver hotel. The dinner/dance is a school function and requires students to meet specific graduation requirements before attending. The Dry Grad raises funds to pay for the Dry Grad event. Both require parent support but the funds are used for two entirely different events. The Dry Grad event is entirely PARENT driven and is NOT a school event.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

As in prior years, we are requesting an up-front one-time only cash family contribution of \$100.00 to offset the cost and greatly decrease the amount of fundraising required. **The contribution is not in lieu of volunteering.** For anyone who is unable to contribute their time to this event – we will gladly accept more ☺.
